Uganda

Bruce and Pam have been serving in Uganda since 2005 where Bruce's church-planting students have established over 100 new churches across Uganda and other African nations.

In 2024, after nearly 22 years with MTW, Bruce and Pam transitioned to work with the Trinity Center for World Missions (TCWM) as their Vice President, continuing their focus on training leaders for the church in Africa. Bruce also serves as a part-time interim pastor at Holy Cross Church in Marana, AZ. He coaches leaders of TCWM's seminaries in Uganda and Rwanda and regularly travels to teach and support faculty. Pam, deeply committed to prayer, spends hours each morning praying for family, ministry, and global Kingdom work. She leads multiple prayer groups and joins others in fasting and prayer.
