The Lord's Supper

*All believers in Jesus Christ who are members in good standing of a Gospel-preaching church are invited to join us in communion. Children and others who this does not describe are asked to abstain and consider the promises of the Gospel during this time.
(1 Cor. 11:27-29; Romans 10:9-10)*

Heidelberg Catechism #66-68

Q. 66. What are sacraments?

A. **Sacraments are visible, holy signs and seals. They were instituted by God so that by our use of them he might make us understand more clearly the promise of the gospel, and seal that promise. And this is God's gospel promise: he grants us forgiveness of sins and eternal life by grace because of Christ's one sacrifice accomplished on the cross.**

Q. 67. Are both the word and the sacraments then intended to focus our faith on the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross as the only ground of our salvation?

A. **Yes indeed! The Holy Spirit teaches us in the gospel and confirms by the holy sacraments that our entire salvation rests on Christ's one sacrifice for us on the cross.**

Q. 68. How many sacraments did Christ institute in the New Testament?

A. **Two: holy baptism and the holy supper.**

Verity Pregnancy and Medical Resource Center provides free medical, educational and support services to women and men facing an unplanned pregnancy or sexual health concerns. Verity provides compassionate and nonjudgmental counsel to anyone suspecting or in an unplanned pregnancy by providing no charge pregnancy testing, health department approved 'proof of pregnancy' as well as grace and forgiveness counseling of women who have had abortions.

Praises:

- They saw twice as many fathers in May than in each of the prior months this year!
- God has brought the most clients they have ever seen this last month, serving 130 clients!

Prayer Requests:

- For clients who are pregnant and battling addiction. Pray for them to check themselves into rehab and for God to protect their babies. Pray for God to set them free from addiction, and for their salvation.
- For a mother of three, all under the age of six: she is pregnant again. Pray for her to choose life for her baby, and for her to see God's hand of provision and love in her life. Pray for her salvation.
- For many pregnant teens we are ministering to at this time. They have chosen life for their babies but desperately need God as their refuge and strength. Pray for their salvation.
- For women who are post abortion bible study. Pray that they will know that God forgives, heals and will walk alongside them as they grieve their loss.
