The Heights Center, supported by the Heights Foundation, works to build strong self-sufficient families in the Harlem Heights neighborhood. They are a deed ministry and support education and wellness, promote family and community development, and provide the benefits of the arts.

Praise:

- Just a few days ago ground was broken for the Career Tech Center. This is primarily a vocational education center for adults. There is a huge need for post-high school training in the community, and fund-raising is going well.
- Opening of the Center is planned for August, 2026.
