The Lord's Supper

*All believers in Jesus Christ who are members in good standing of a Gospel-preaching church are invited to join us in communion. Children and others who this does not describe are asked to abstain and consider the promises of the Gospel during this time.
(1 Cor. 11:27-29; Romans 10:9-10)*

Heidelberg Catechism #77

Q. 77. Where does Christ promise to nourish and refresh believers with his body and blood as surely as they eat this broken bread and drink this cup?

A. **In the institution of the Lord's Supper: "The Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks he broke it, and said, 'Take, eat, this is my body which is broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.' For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes." This promise is repeated by Paul in these words: "The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread."**

International

The Gideons is an Association of Christian business and professional men and their wives dedicated to telling people about Jesus through associating together for service, sharing personal testimony and distributing Bibles and New Testaments.

Praise:

- In February of this year at least 25,000 Bibles and New Testaments were distributed to hotels, high schools, colleges, medical offices and first responders. 71 Gideons and auxiliary members from 23 Florida camps came to Fort Myers to accomplish this major distribution.
- One of our own Westminster members has been sharing the gospel locally. One person has made a profession of faith and a second person is "in-process" he knows nothing about Jesus and our own Gideon is in extended discussions with him.

Prayer:

- On August 14th there will be training on personal witnessing during the Gideon State Convention in St. Augustine. 80 or more Gideons and their wives will then go out on the streets in St. Augustine to share the gospel. Pray that they will encounter prepared hearts and many divine appointments.
