## Heidelberg Catechism #110-111

Q. 110. What does God forbid in the eighth commandment?

A. He forbids not only outright theft and robbery, which governing authorities punish, but in God's sight theft also includes all evil tricks and schemes designed to get our neighbor's goods for ourselves, whether by force or means that appear legitimate, such as inaccurate measurements of weight, size, or volume; fraudulent merchandising; counterfeit money; excessive interest; or any other means forbidden by God. In addition God forbids all greed and pointless squandering of his gifts.

Q. 111. What does God require of you in this commandment?

A. That I do whatever I can and may for my neighbor's good, that I treat others as I would like them to treat me, and that I work faithfully so that I may help the needy in their hardship.

LOGOI is a Bible resource and pastoral training ministry whose specialty is practical, trusted and effective on-the-job Bible training. The ministry of LOGOI has been working in Venezuela since the 1970s. Ali's primary ministry is in the area of family counseling, and Celia oversees their children's ministries in Valencia.

### Praise:

- LOGOI ministers to nearly 1,000 Venezuelans through its Bible Resource Center. Ali shares that LOGOI materials form the foundation of his teaching, especially the counseling courses, and allow him to immediately apply what he is learning.
- Cesar Gotopo (Venezuela): After a crisis of faith, God used a LOGOI course to bring Cesar back to faith. He now ministers to college students in Maracaibo.
- Carlos Gonzalez Berrotaran (Argentina): Raised in a home marked by witchcraft and addiction, Carlos came to faith through a crusade. He now teaches in his church and serves as LOGOI's *Missionary of the Month*, with hopes of becoming a full-time pastor.

- That the many students will follow through and complete all their assignments.
- For peace in Venezuela. As Ali shares, "With all the hardships in our country, family counseling is very important and needed."
