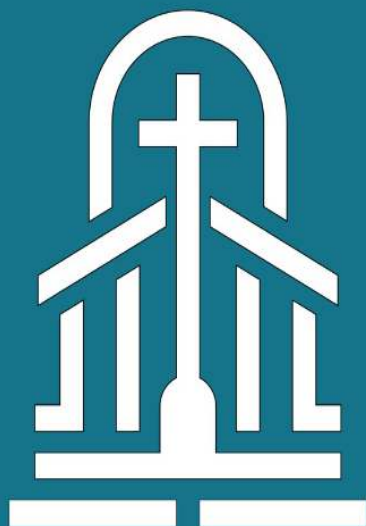

Call To Worship

Because worship begins with God and not us, we begin our gatherings each Sunday with a “Call To Worship”, where we intentionally start by focusing our attention on the character, nature, and deeds of our God. This involves reading a passage of Scripture (usually a Psalm) which helps us center our attention on God’s holy attributes and actions, while inviting us to join together in proclaiming his praise. Jesus is the Author & Perfecter of our faith, so we want to begin each week by fixing our eyes on him. (Hebrews 12:2)
